## Optional Residential - 170

Basic monthly service .....	\$28
Energy charge per kWh June 1 - Sept 30 .....	6.21¢

Energy charge per kWh Oct 1 – May 31 .....	5.35¢
Demand charge per kW Oct 1 – May 31 .....	\$5.69

The demand to be billed in any billing month shall not be less than 50% of the maximum demand registered during the preceding billing months of June, July, August and September.

**On Peak: 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. CST (8 a.m. – 9 p.m. DST) all weekdays.**

**Off Peak: All other hours (including weekends).**

### All Rates May Be Subject To The Following Rate Schedule Riders:

**Power Cost Adjustment (PCA)** – The PCA is a direct pass-through of any charges or credits that MiEnergy Cooperative receives from our wholesale power supplier to account for fluctuations in the energy market.

**Conservation Improvement Program Cost Recovery Adjustment** – The amount dedicated to the recovery of CIP costs (i.e. energy efficiency rebates for cooling, lighting, appliances, etc.) as approved by the Minnesota PUC and adjusted annually.

**Residential/Non-Residential Second Nature Renewable Energy Program** – Voluntary purchase of renewable energy

**Street Lighting** – Includes Company, Municipal, or Residential Lighting.

**Co-generation Small Power Producers** – Net Energy, Purchase & Sale, Time of Day and Distributed Generation.

**Tax Adjustment** – Includes federal, state or local tax charges in addition to any franchise fees
